

Western Region Annual Championships

Individual Western Region Championship

Western Region Championship awards are unclassified, and based on seasonal aggregate performance for our three main small arms competitions: Musket, Carbine, and Smoothbore. Aggregate points will be awarded to each individual based on highest individual scores posted for each event without regard to classifications for musket and carbine. The following 6 events at each regional skirmish will be counted:

25-yd and 50-yd smoothbore
50-yd and 100 -yd musket
50-yd and 100-yd carbine

Championship points will be awarded on this basis at each skirmish: High score = 5 pts, 2nd = 4 pts, 3rd = 3 pts, 4th = 2 pts, 5th = 1 pt. On this basis, a shooter could in theory pick up as many as 30 points in a single skirmish.

- The five approved regional skirmishes for 2009 will apply to this championship;
- Where allowed by N-SSA rules, host units will at the discretion of the Skirmish Director allow their members to fire at least one individual relay at their hosted skirmish, manpower permitting. N-SSA rules prohibit individual competition by the Skirmish Director and Statistics Officer;
- At joint N-SSA/ACWSA skirmishes, Individuals may accrue championship points regardless of the affiliation of the team with which they shoot during that skirmish;
- Statistics Officers at each skirmish will provide a list of the top 5 scorers WHO ARE WESTERN REGION N-SSA MEMBERS to the Western Region Secretary (Jim Leinicke) for each of the above 6 qualifying events after each skirmish.

Team Championship

The overall Team Championship will be computed on the same basis as the Individual Championship, with the following additional provisions:

- Where manpower permits, N-SSA host teams are encouraged to field teams at their own skirmish so long as the team is disqualified for skirmish awards per N-SSA rules and so long as the designated Skirmish Director and Statistics Officer do not shoot. A team hosting a skirmish and unable to field teams due to manpower restrictions shall automatically accumulate 3-pts per event missed as a result of hosting the skirmish;
- At joint N-SSA/ACWSA skirmishes, only teams competing as a legal N-SSA organization and composed entirely of N-SSA members shall qualify for championship points;
- The Statistics Officer for each skirmish shall provide a list of winning organizations to the Western Region Secretary after each skirmish and shall certify which teams at joint skirmishes qualify for Western Region championship points.
